# *Camp Directors Message*

## ***Dear RMWC Participant and Parents:***

This package is confirmation of your registration for the 2017 Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp and full payment is now due. We are looking forward to having you attend our camp and hope that you will enjoy yourself while improving and learning new wrestling skills

***The camp will be challenging therefore it is highly recommended that you are training for at least 3 weeks either on or off the mat prior to arriving at camp. Our expectation is that you will arrive at camp healthy and mentally prepared to work hard.***

If you have any questions or concerns regarding medical concerns please contact me. Any athlete who has had a concussion in the 6 weeks prior to the start of camp must have proper medical clearance to participate. It is the responsibility of all parents and participants to completely disclose any health concerns in the paperwork sent out in order to best take care of the athletes.

Our onsite physiotherapist will be available to assess and treat injured athletes. Please note that my protocol for contacting parents regarding injured athletes is only in case of an emergency or the athlete is taken to hospital for further examination. Lastly, please monitor skin issues prior to arriving at camp. Athletes will be skin checked upon arrival and if found to be contagious, they will not be allowed to participate in the camp.

# REGISTRATION

## CHECK-IN:

All participants must check in at the Jasper Activity Center between 12:00 - 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 16th, 2017. The Jasper Activity Center is located on Pyramid Avenue.

## FORMS: TO BE HANDED IN AT REGISTRATION

***Waiver and Assumption of Risk Form*** - This camp waiver and assumption of risk agreement must be signed by both the participant and parent/guardian prior to the individual being able to participate in the camp.

***Conduct Agreement Form*** - Signifies the athlete and parent(s) understand and are in agreement with the camp rules at the Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp.

***Medical Form*** - Please complete the enclosed medical history form. Any pertinent information (ie. special health problems) should be brought to the attention of the Camp Director and the Head Therapist.

***Activity Day Form*** - an afternoon has been set aside for "Activity Day". On this day, athletes will be invited to take part in many of the fun-filled and challenging activities, which are attractions of the Jasper National Park. These activities and the cost of each are listed on the enclosed sheet. At the **time of registration**, please bring this sheet with the activity you plan to participate in circled and the appropriate amount of money if you have not already paid. **(Cash only please) It is preferable that you pay prior to arriving at camp.**

**There are separate waivers for some of the activities. Please see attached.**

## TRANSPORTATION

Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from Jasper.

If you are taking a bus or train- **other than that provided by Edmonton Amateur Wrestling** to camp, please advise us and we will arrange transportation to and from the bus/train depot.

All participants must use camp transportation while at camp. Any camper who brings a vehicle to camp must turn in keys to the director at the start of camp.

## **ACCOMMODATION**

Participants will be staying at the Jasper High School & Jasper Activity Center. Everyone must bring a sleeping bag and pillow. Foam mattresses will be provided. If anyone needs to get a message to a participant, messages can be left through Camp Director Owen Dawkins cell # 780-966-5586

## **MEALS**

Campers will receive 3 meals per day. Participants are welcome to eat as much as they want during scheduled meal times. Anyone wanting additional food (e.g. snacks) must bring extra spending money for this purpose. **NO FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE DORMS.** Lock boxes are available for athletes to store snacks.

The Jasper Activity Center fines any camp \$50 each time food is found in the dorms.

It will be the responsibility of the guilty party to pay any such fines.

## **MEDICAL SERVICES**

There will be a physiotherapist on site during scheduled wrestling times. Tape and other medical supplies will be provided by the camp. Please ensure that your son/daughter's medical information form is complete with all information pertaining to current or previous medical conditions.

Please be advised that in the case of an injured athlete, the athlete will be assessed by the Physiotherapist and then in consultation with the camp director will determine the course of action. Depending on the nature of the injury parents may or may not be notified by the camp director.

## **CAMP BANK**

Participants are advised to make use of the camp bank, which will be set up on the day of registration in order to ensure spending money and other valuables are kept safe. The camp bank will be opened twice daily for campers to access their spending money.

## Camp Rules

Under the direction of our outstanding camp instructors, you will receive instruction, training and competitive situations during the morning, afternoon and evening sessions.

You will be under the direct supervision of camp staff. **Once again, the Camp Director has the right to return home, at parent's/guardian's expense any participant who violates any of the following camp rules or displays unacceptable behavior. No fees will be refunded.**

1. Attendance at ALL camp sessions and activities is MANDATORY.
2. No drugs, tobacco products, or alcohol.
3. Participants must be in their rooms and lights out at designated times.
4. Absolutely no food or drink is allowed in the dorm areas.
5. Participants must sign out if leaving the campus unless accompanied by a staff member or by previous arrangement with Camp Director. (Signed out on dorm list)
6. No visitors to the campus unless authorized by the camp director.
7. Abusive language or other unruly behavior will not be tolerated. Serious misbehavior will result in the athlete being sent home at the Camp Director's discretion. The cost for this will be billed to the participant's parents.
8. No private automobiles are to be used while at camp. Campers will be asked to turn car keys over to the camp director for the duration of the camp.
9. Any damage done by a participant to facilities or equipment will be billed to the participant's parents.
10. Proper attire including shirts and shoes must be worn when in the cafeteria during meal times and around the campus.

# 2017 Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp

## Policies and Procedures

### PREAMBLE

1. The Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp (RMWC) is committed to providing a sport environment, which is athlete centered and which is characterized by open, clear communication and honesty, fairness and mutual respect.
2. The Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp believes that these values and ideals should guide all our communications and actions, and that such conduct is in the best interests of all those who participate in the sport of wrestling.
3. Attendance at the Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp brings with it many benefits and privileges. At the same time, camp participants are fully expected to fulfill certain responsibilities and obligations, including but not limited to, complying with policies, rules and regulations of the Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp.
4. The following code of conduct identifies the standard of behavior, which is expected of all Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp participants. Camp participants who fail to meet this standard will be subject to disciplinary actions (procedures) identified within this policy.
5. The Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp is a private camp and reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any person into the camp without due justification and/or ask any participants to leave the camp without reason.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

Camp participants shall conduct themselves so as to reasonably comply with the following code of conduct:

- a) Attend all sessions regularly and punctually.
- b) Cooperate fully with everyone authorized by the Camp to provide activities and other services.
- c) Refrain from consumption or possession of any alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or tobacco products (no smoking).
- d) Respect the property associated with the Camp, including facilities, equipment, and others belongings (No theft or vandalism).
- e) Avoid acts of rowdy, abusive conduct, or language in relations with the other camp participants or camp staff including coaches and instructors.
- f) Avoid any action or conduct that would disrupt or interfere with the Camp.
- g) Behave in an exemplary manner, exhibiting sportsman-like conduct.
- h) Observe the regulations and curfews established by the Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camp staff.
- i) Avoid pranks, jokes, fighting, or other activities, which may endanger the safety of others.
- j) Observe the laws of Canada, Alberta and the town site of Jasper.
- k) Comply with the rule that Camp participants must not leave designated areas at the Camp unless accompanied by a staff member or by previous arrangement with the Camp Director.
- l) Comply with the rule that no private automobiles are to be used by Camp participants during the duration of the Camp.

### DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS (Procedures)

Procedures for dealing with minor infractions shall be informal as compared to those for major infractions and shall be determined at the discretion of the Camp Director, provided the individual being disciplined is told the nature of the infraction and has an opportunity to provide information concerning the incident. Minor and major infractions are outlined below.

### EXAMPLES OF MINOR INFRACTIONS

- a) A single incident of disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist, or sexist comments or behavior directed towards others, including but not limited to peers, opponents, athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, spectators, and sponsors.
- b) Unsportsman-like conduct such as angry outbursts or arguing.
- c) A single incident of being late or absent from RMWC events and activities at which attendance is expected or required.
- d) Non-compliance with the rules and regulations under which RMWC events are conducted.
- e) Curfew violations outlined by camp.

### EXAMPLES OF MAJOR INFRACTIONS

- a) Repeated incidents of disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist, or sexist comments or behavior directed towards others, including but not limited to peers, opponents, athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, spectators, and sponsors.
- b) Repeated unsportsman-like conduct such as angry outbursts or arguing.
- c) Repeated incidents of being late or absent from RMWC events and activities at which attendance is expected or required.
- d) Activities or behavior which interferes with a competition or with any athletes preparation for a competition.

- e) Pranks, jokes, fighting, or other activities which may endanger the safety of others.
- f) Deliberate disregard for the rules and regulations under which RMWC events are conducted.
- g) Consumption of alcohol, illicit drugs, or use of narcotics.
- h) Any vandalism or theft with respect to participants' property or facility grounds.

The following disciplinary actions may be applied, singly or in combination, for minor infractions:

- a) Verbal reprimand to infractor.
- b) Written reprimand to be placed in infractor's file.
- c) Verbal apology required by infractor.
- d) Hand delivered written apology authored by infractor addressed to camp staff and the Alberta Amateur Wrestling Association.
- e) Disciplinary actions that may be considered appropriate for the offense.

Minor infractions, which result in discipline shall be recorded using the Incident Report form. If the incident is to be dealt with as a major infraction it shall be recorded using the Incident Report form. The alleged offender shall be notified as quickly as possible and shall be advised of the procedures to follow.

During any hearings that take place for a major infraction, the individual being disciplined shall have the right to present their side of the incident in addition to the presence of a lawyer or another adult. This right may be waived in writing by the infractor after being advised of their right. The hearing shall be held in private by the director, staff and other parties involved. Those conducting the hearing may request that witnesses to the incident be present or submit written evidence. It is at the Director's discretion to suspend the activities of any persons charged with a major infraction until the matter is heard and dealt with promptly.

The following disciplinary actions may be applied, singly or in combination, for major infractions at the sole discretion:

- a) Written reprimand to be placed in infractor's file.
- b) Hand delivered written apology authored by infractor addressed to camp staff and the Alberta Amateur Wrestling Association.
- c) Other disciplinary actions as may be considered appropriate for offense.
- d) Expulsion of the Camp participant from the camp. (i.e. sent home at their own expense)

Before a camp participant is sent home, the camp director shall immediately contact the camp participant's parent or guardian and inform them of their child being withdrawn from the camp, the reasons for withdrawal, and establish travel arrangements and times for the camp participant to get home.

**WARNING BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU GIVE UP THE RIGHT TO SUE FOR ANY INJURY OR DAMAGE HOWSOEVER CAUSED**

To **Jasper Park Riding Stables & Outfitters Ltd.**, employees, representatives, officers, and agents of **Jasper Park Riding Stables & Outfitters Ltd.** and **Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada** as represented by **Parks Canada**.

I hereby sign this agreement on behalf of myself, my personal representatives, heirs and assigns.

1. I agree as a precondition to my participation in trail rides, wagon/sleigh rides or hunting/fishing and related activities organized by **Jasper Park Riding Stables & Outfitters Ltd.** and conducted by **Jasper Park Riding Stables & Outfitters Ltd.** and/or Employees of **Jasper Park Riding Stables & Outfitters Ltd.** and in further consideration of **Jasper Park Riding Stables & Outfitters Ltd.** allowing me to do so, to be strictly bound by the terms of this Waiver, Assumption Of Risk and Indemnity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "The Agreement").
2. I acknowledge that trail rides, wagon/sleigh rides of hunting/fishing and related activities involve **INHERENT RISKS** that may cause serious injury and possibly death to participants. I further recognize that backcountry trails, horse, wagon/sleigh rides and hunting fishing activities involve **ADDITIONAL RISKS AND DANGERS**.
3. I Fully understand the risks and dangers associated with my participation in this wagon/sleigh/trail ride or hunting/fishing and related activities and **ACCEPT SAME ENTIRELY AT MY OWN RISK**.
4.
