As it is impossible to avoid all risks of physical harm associated with the sport of wrestling, the parents/guardians of minors who wish to participate in the Golden Bears Takedown Tournament must sign the following Release form.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Release, Indemnity, Waiver and Voluntary Assumption of Risks</p> <p>Summer Wrestling Camp, and in consideration of the child being allowed to participate in classes, we, for ourselves and for and on behalf of the child do hereby voluntarily assume any and all risks, both known and unknown, associated with the child's participation in the sport of wrestling, and we hereby release and discharge the University of Alberta Wrestling Club, their respective officers, employees, agents, referees, instructors, coaches, members and representatives (hereafter collectively referred to as the "Releasees") from all and any claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs or expenses in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to the child's person or property, however caused, arising out of or in connection with the child attending, participating in, practicing for, receiving instruction or competing in the sport of wrestling, or arising out of or in connection with the child traveling to or from any wrestling camps, training, , notwithstanding that the loss or damage may have been caused by or contributed to by the negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty of care as occupier of premises , or otherwise, of the Releasees or any of them.</p> <p>Further, we certify that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The child is in good physical condition and has no injury or disease that would increase the risk of physical injury arising from the child's participation in the sport of wrestling. 2. No physician, nurse, therapist, or other medical expert or practitioner has advised me that the child should not compete in body contact sports, in strenuous physical activities, or the sport of wrestling. 3. We are the father and mother of the child or the legal guardians of the child and are the persons lawfully entitled to act for and on behalf of the child 4. We agree that this document shall be binding on the child, ourselves, and the heirs, executors, administrators, assigns and personal representatives of each of us.
