**OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTOR:** This award is to recognize individuals within our sport who have demonstrated exceptional leadership qualities or service to any wrestling group or association for the past year.

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** This award is to recognize those individuals who dedicate many hours of volunteer labor to Alberta wrestling but are neither coaches nor officials.

**ALBERTA AMATEUR WRESTLING HALL OF FAME** (replaces Lifetime Achievement Award)

Nominees must have been a permanent resident of Alberta during the relevant part of his/her career.

## **Athlete**

- Shall be evaluated with respect to his/her contribution to our sport at the international and national levels.
- Must be retired from national championships or higher-level competitions
- Evaluation will be on his/her personal achievements, awards, or accomplishments and on their contributions and the impact they made to our sport in their community, Alberta, and Canada

## **Builder**

- A builder is a coach, trainer, manager, official, administrator, volunteer.
- Consideration will be given to both paid and unpaid nominees.
- A builder does not have to be retired to be considered and shall be evaluated based on his/her outstanding contribution, normally over the course of 10 years or more, not necessarily consecutive.
